Week 1: June 2-8

Week 2: June 9-15

Using food, show us the different phases of the moon.

Week 3: June 16-22

Strut your stuff! We all want to see your finest moonwalk.

Week 4: June 23-29

Remember that time you were abducted by aliens? Neither do we. But could you show us how it happened? We're very curious.

Week 5: June 30-July 6

Hey, are you a time traveler? Yeah, that's what we thought. If you're really from the future, why don't you take a picture of your cool time-traveling machine?

Week 6: July 7-13

A long time ago, in a library far, far away ... reenact your favorite scene from *Star Wars* and share it with us.

Week 7: July 14-20

Take a picture with a robot. Can't find a robot? Well, I guess you're going to have to build one. Make sure that it follows the Three Laws of Robotics, and then take a picture with it.

Week 8: July 21-27
